

Music Theatre Workshop is a fourterm study within the Theatre Arts program. It is a performance-based course that introduces students to different ways of working, new performance vocabulary and the particular skills required to devise and realise a work in this performance style.



The work created by Ross Hannaford, Nick Hedger and the members of the Company focuses on what it means to become a unique individual, to know what is important and what should be challenged, to be resilient, to be kind to others and to understand the power and responsibilities of agency.

A genuine 'ensemble' piece, Fight! is an ambitious work: a multi-voiced narrative punctuated by songs that advance rather than just embellish the story. I hope that audiences enjoy the work as much as I have enjoyed watching its realisation over the past seven months.
