


DIRECTOR | Eliza McTaggart

PYTHIA

MUSIC | *Pythia* by Amanati CHOREOGRAPHY | Mishka Oehlers DANCERS | Year 10

I was inspired by the title of my music. In Greek Mythology, *Pythia* was the high priestess of the Oracle of Apollo at Delphi. Pythia was said to rule over all and influence everyone to follow her. I took this idea and represented it in my piece through the idea that in modern society, we lack identity and often suffer from the influence of people with power. It has been a wonderful journey working with Year 10s and I have loved seeing how their bodies and minds interpret my choreography.



PARODIE DE MARIAGE

MUSIC | Four Seasons: Spring by Vivaldi CHOREOGRAPHY | Celina Ung DANCERS | Year 7 & 9

My dance *Parodie de Mariage*; French for 'Wedding Parody', is inspired by one of life's biggest moments: weddings. This dance begins with the wedding unfolding as planned and develops into a funny parody of a celebration gone wrong. Filled with chaos from misbehaving flower girls and boys and a bride distraught over her bridesmaids' jealous feelings. It's been a pleasure working with the Year 7s and 9s and seeing this piece come together!



DISTORTIONS

MUSIC | Why Try to Change Me Now by Fiona Apple CHOREOGRAPHY | Matilda (Tilly) Eardley DANCERS | Year 10

My piece explores themes of isolation and exclusion, as a group of four people drive an individual to the point of insanity. I've enjoyed collaborating with my selected dancers as this piece has developed, and am very proud of how they have brought my vision to life.



A LULL

GOLDWING

This piece explores the movement qualities of falling and floating. Our work focuses on bird-like actions which is inspired from the name of our music: Goldwing. We have loved working with the Year 9 & 10 cohort and can't wait to see our vision come to life.





WELCOME TO THE 60'S

MUSIC | The Nicest Kids In Town by Marc Shaiman & Scott Michael Wittman from the movie Hairspray CHOREOGRAPHY | Abbey Jones DANCERS | Year 8

I have really enjoyed working on this dance with the amazing Year 8s! This dance is inspired by the dance crazes of the 6os, with a musical theatre influence.



DUAS TER

MUSIC | Alarms by Bryce Dessner (Australian String Quartet)
CHOREOGRAPHY | Connor Bevis & Martin Cohen
DANCERS | Year 10

In our piece, we created movements that responded to the music, building off the rhythm, tempo and pitch. Each duo represents a differentiation in the music which is partnered with a change in movement quality.



VISIONS

MUSIC | Visions of Gideon by Sufjan Stevens CHOREOGRAPHY | Tilly Eardley & Emogen Gough DANCERS | Year 9

This piece is inspired by the concept of memories and exploring the different stages of one's life. Trying to figure out what's real and what's not. We have loved working with the Year 9 cohort as they've embodied our contemporary-style choreography and helped to bring our ideas to life.



RUN THE WORLD

MUSIC | Run the World (Girls) by Beyoncé CHOREOGRAPHY | Banjo Chiron DANCERS | Year 7, 8, 9 & 10 Girls

I was inspired by the artist Beyoncé and how she is such a role model to lots of girls, so I decided to put together an all female dance. I have really loved working with all the girls to put together this powerful hip hop/commercial piece.



DUALITY

MUSIC | Paint It, Black performed by Absolutely Grand Orchestra (Instrumental Version)

CHOREOGRAPHY | Ryan Black

DANCERS | Year 10

This piece explores the complexities of how two groups can coexist. It focuses on the themes of harmony and conflict. 'Duality' explores the use of group structures and the arrangement of dancers in space.



CINGULOMANIA

MUSIC | Hotline by Billie Eilish, Only by RY X CHOREOGRAPHY | Keira Lee DANCERS | Year 8

I have decided to explore the concept of 'cingulomania' as the intention of my choreography. *Cingulomania* is the feeling of wanting to be held by someone; a hug. I decided to choreograph my piece on the Year 8s, as I was impressed by the fluidity of their movements and their work ethic. The movements of this piece focus on fluid and circular actions replicating the feeling and motion of a hug.



DESCENT INTO MADNESS

MUSIC | When the Party's Over by Billie Eilish CHOREOGRAPHY | Chloe Dan DANCERS | Year 9 & Year 10

This piece was inspired by the idea of heartbreak making us descend into madness and exploring ways in which that can be embodied through dance. I have loved working with the Year 9s and 10s in this piece, and they have really brought my idea to life.



AND THE WALTZ GOES ON

MUSIC | And The Waltz Goes On by Sir Anthony Hopkins (performed by André Rieu and Johann Strauss Orchestra) CHOREOGRAPHY | Jasmine Pye DANCERS | Year 10

I have been very lucky this season to work with a group of dedicated Year 10 on a piece centred around young love, the fickleness that often comes with it, as well as the instantaneous attachment of young hearts. The feeling of being in love without fully understanding all that it entails.



HUMAN

MUSIC | Human by Sevdaliza CHOREOGRAPHY | Sharon Jiang DANCERS | Year 7 & 8

This piece explores the human inclination to be part of a large group, often neglecting individual's feelings in the process, and adopting the behaviours and actions of the people around them.



CARÁMBANO

MUSIC | Sad Girlz Luv Money (Remix) by Amaarae (featuring Kali Uchis & Moily) CHOREOGRAPHY | Dimitri Bregianis DANCERS | Year 9 & Year 10

I have loved working with members of the 9 and 10 cohort on my piece *Carámbano*, which directly translates to icicle from Spanish. Carámbano is a commercial/hip-hop piece exploring the idea of icicles melting. I wanted to create a work that shows contrast in level, style, and body flow. Transitioning from hard hitting, percussive movements to a more relaxed flow and style. I've worked with the dancers to find interesting movements and phrases that would show the full process of ice melting.



ROADTRIP

MUSIC | Road Trip by Eugune Goh CHOREOGRAPHY | Giselle Mammone DANCERS | Year 8

My piece is inspired by a flock of birds travelling around the stage as one. I was inspired by this idea as it resembles each grade's close knit friendships with each other.

CHOREOGRAPHY | Ella Tan & Eliza McTaggart
