Linda Barcan

Lecturer In Music (Voice) Melbourne Conservatorium of Music

Mezzo-soprano Linda Barcan trained at the Conservatorium of Newcastle, the National Institute of Dramatic Art (NIDA) and the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. A French Government scholarship led to a two-year long engagement with the Opéra de Lyon, followed by a 10-year association with Opera Australia. Linda has an affinity for 20th and 21st century opera, with appearances in Christina's World (Sydney Chamber Opera), Abelard and Heloise (Opera Hunter), Pecan Summer (Short Black Opera) and The Emperor of Atlantis (Lost & Found Opera).

Linda has performed in concert in Australia, France and South-East Asia, including performances with the Sinfonia de Lyon, Sydney Youth Orchestra, L'Ecole Territoriale de Musique and art song and Lieder societies around Australia.

Linda has featured on recordings for Virgin, Decca, Warner and ABC Records, and in broadcasts for ABC-TV, ABC Radio, Radio France and Radio France Outre-Mer.

Curt Thompson

Head of Strings Melbourne Conservatorium of Music

Violinist Curt Thompson was appointed in 2012 as Associate Professor and Head of Strings at the University of Melbourne Conservatorium of Music. He is Founder and Executive Director of the Fort Worth, Texas-based Mimir Chamber Music Festival.

Thompson performs throughout the Americas, Europe, Asia, and Australia as concerto soloist, recitalist, concertmaster, and chamber musician in such prestigious venues as Carnegie's Weill Recital Hall, Salle Gaveau (Paris), Teatro Naçional de Costa Rica (San José) and the Shanghai Concert Hall.

Concerto appearances include the Qingdao Symphony (China), Medellín Philharmonic Orchestra (Colombia), the symphonies of Corpus Christi, San Angelo, Las Colinas, Irving, Arlington, Garland, and the Texas Chamber Orchestra. As Concertmaster, Curt has performed with the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra, Fort Worth Symphony Orchestra, Spoleto Festival Orchestra (Italy), and the Corpus Christi, Las Colinas, and San Angelo symphonies.

He has given master classes at the Royal Academy of Music (London), The Juilliard School, Beijing Central Conservatory, El Escorial Conservatory (Spain), and the Bulgarian State Academy of Music. Curt has served as juror in the National Concerto Competition of New Zealand, the Pancho Vladigerov International Violin Competition (Bulgaria) and the Dorcas Mclean competition (Australia), and on the Artistic Committee of the Melbourne International Chamber Music Competition.
